

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**BEDFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL PROPOSES TO INTRODUCE PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN BRICKHILL WARD**

Reason for proposal: Bedford Borough Council has received a request from the Ward Councillors for Brickhill Ward to introduce parking restrictions on various roads to address concerns of inconsiderate parking.

Effect of the Order:

**1. To introduce ‘no waiting at anytime’ (double yellow lines) restrictions on the following lengths of road:**

<b>A</b>	<b>Pipit Rise</b>
(i)	On both sides of the road extending a distance approximately 9 metres in a western direction from its junction with Larkway.
<b>B</b>	<b>Larkway</b>
(i)	Upon its western kerb extending a distance approximately 16 metres in both a northern and southern direction from its junction with Pipit Rise.
<b>C</b>	<b>Waveney Avenue</b>
(i)	Upon its northern kerb extending from a point approximately 11 metres east of its junction with Severn Way for a distance approximately 37 metres in an eastern direction.
<b>D</b>	<b>Ashmead Road</b>
(i)	On its southern kerb extending a distance approximately 21 metres in a western direction from its junction with Tyne Crescent
(ii)	On its northern kerb extending a distance approximately 132 metres in a western direction from its junction with Tyne Crescent
<b>E</b>	<b>Tyne Crescent</b>
(i)	On its western kerb extending a distance approximately 24 metres in a northern direction from its junction with Ashmead Road.

"Grid Reference L18: Sheet Revision No 3" shall be substituted
- (iii) "Grid Reference L21: Sheet Revision No 1" shall be deleted and  
"Grid Reference L21: Sheet Revision No 2" shall be substituted
