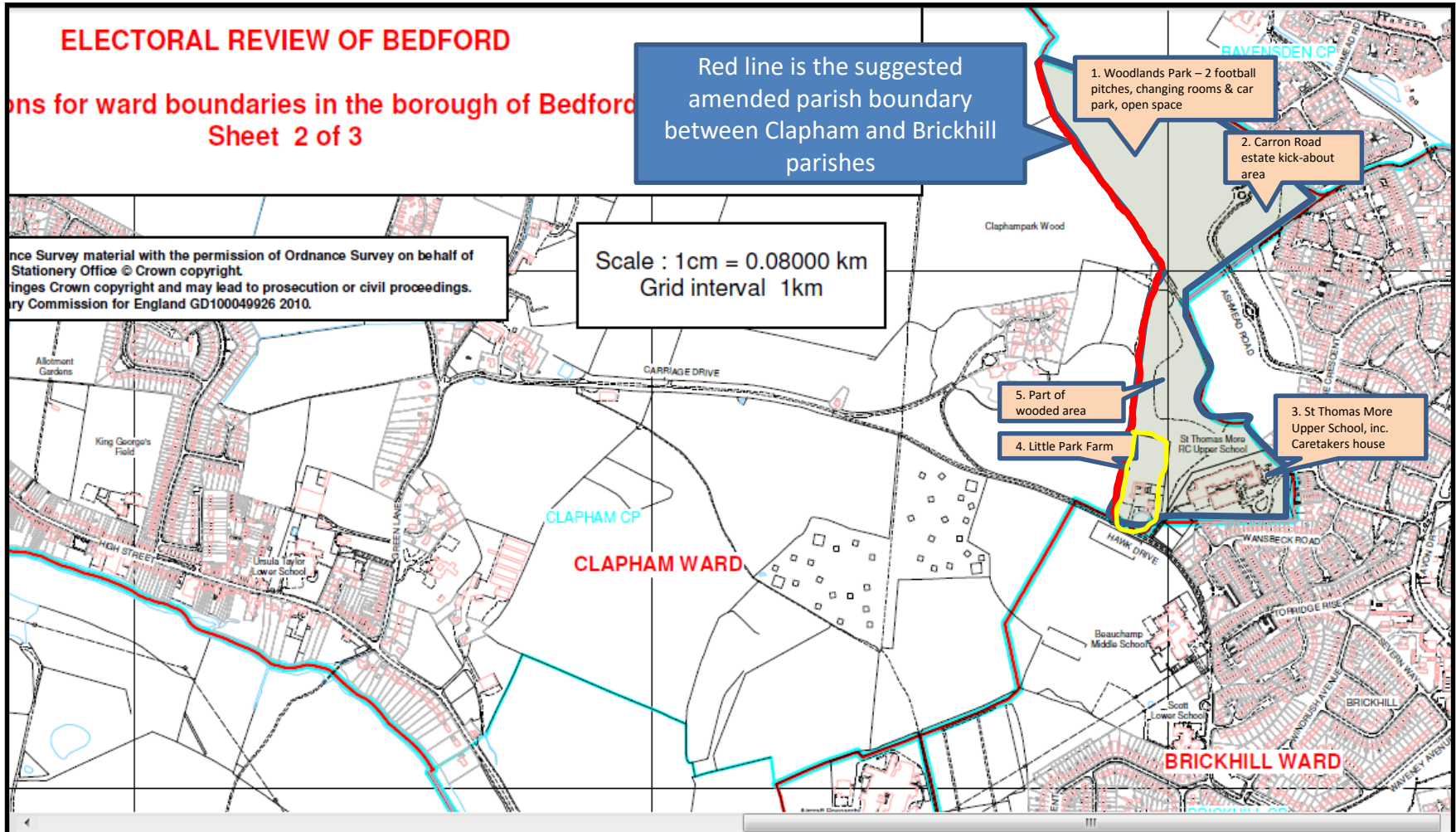


Suggested amendment to parish boundaries – Clapham/Brickhill



Notes on suggested Clapham/Brickhill boundary changes

On the previous slide, the area suggested to be moved from Clapham to Brickhill parishes is shaded.

1. Woodlands Park – 2 football pitches, changing rooms & car park, open space

This is accessed from Ashmead Road, off Tyne Crescent. A 3rd football pitch is part of the site and became part of Brickhill Parish on 1st April 2015 along with the whole of the Woodlands Park estate and the Country Park. Ashmead Road is the sole vehicular access to the Woodlands Park estate; both ends of this road are in Brickhill but a short section runs through Clapham Parish.

2. Carron Road estate kick-about area

This is immediately adjacent to the Carron Road estate, between the estate and Ashmead Road.

3. St Thomas More Upper School, inc. Caretakers house

A small part of the site is in Brickhill Parish, the rest is in Clapham Parish. It is accessed from Kennet Rise, off Tyne Crescent, in Brickhill.

4. Little Park Farm

This is accessed from Hawk Drive in Brickhill. The rest of Hawk Drive, including the two neighbouring bungalows, are in Brickhill Parish already.

5. Part of wooded area

If the boundary of Little Park Farm is followed due north, to where it intersects with the border between Clapham Park Wood and the Woodlands Park football pitches and open space, it would take in part of this wooded area. In order to simplify the boundary, I suggest that this area is also moved into Brickhill Parish.
