

PARLIAMENTARY POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES REVIEW 2014

BEDFORD CONSTITUENCY

BRICKHILL BOROUGH WARD

The map of Brickhill Ward is available on the following page identifying the proposed Polling Districts. The Ward has seven Polling Districts. Details of the reference letters and the electorate are set out below. The principal change from existing arrangements is to create three new Polling Districts for those areas to be excluded from Brickhill Parish (but still within Brickhill Borough Ward) with effect from 1 April 2015:

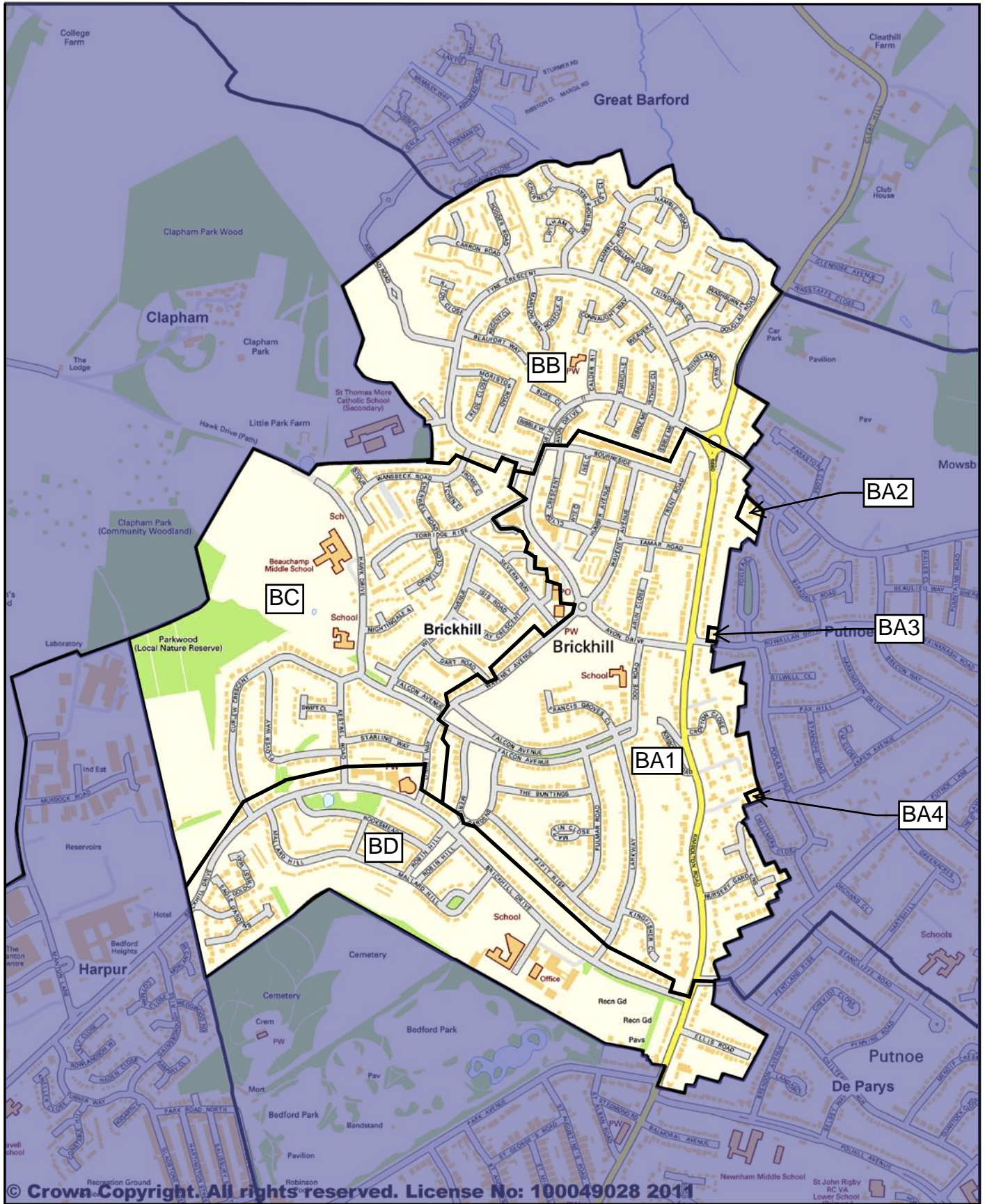
POTENTIAL DEVELOPMENT
